**Garden of Rest and Reflection:** Sincere thanks to everyone involved in the construction and the creation of the beautiful space at St. Mary's Church, adjacent to Our Lady's Grotto. To everyone who volunteered and generously donated to this place of rest and reflection, our sincere thanks and appreciation.

**St. Mary's and St. Rynagh's:** The stained-glass windows in both Churches need repair. Abbey Stained Glass Windows have inspected the windows in both Churches and the cost of repair and restoration work amounts to €110,809. The Finance Committee have discussed the project and a decision has been made to proceed with the work in stages. It is hoped that the work will commence in early June. In St. Mary's Church the window in the Gallery will be restored and in St. Rynagh's the Rose window over the altar will also be repaired costing €15,355. We have received a grant from Offaly Co. Council – Built Heritage Investment Scheme 2021 for €4,300 towards the windows. The lead in the Gallery Window is loose and rattling in the wind and has lost a lot of the cement in the lead comes. This window will have to be taken out completely and restored in the Abbey Stained Glass workshop. When put back it will have to be properly storm glazed. The Rose Window has not been storm glazed so this will be carried out to protect it. **Feast of the Most Sacred Heart** celebrated on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June.
