She became a Catholic in 1922 and a Carmelite nun. On the 9th August 1942 she died in Auschwitz.

National Heritage Week 12th – 20th August: Local historians Kieran Keenaghan and James Scully will give a fascinating presentation in Banagher Library – Thurs. 17th Aug. 6.30 p.m., which will provide some interesting insights into the history of the locality. The talk will reveal that an earlier name for Banagher was Áth Cróich where the renowned High-King of Ireland, Turlough O' Connor built a bridge in the year 1120. They will also explain the origins of the town's current name Banagher, and the well-known phrase Well!! "That Beats Banagher, and Banagher beats the devil." The speakers will focus on the Irish writings of Mathew De Renzy, a German merchant, who lived at Clonony Castle, near Banagher in the 1620s. They will also discuss De Renzy's wife Anne and her wonderful castle, built nearby at Moystown at that time. This is sure to be a most enjoyable and informative evening.
