First Banagher Brontë Weekend: The long awaited first Banagher Brontë Weekend will take place from Fri. 19th to Sun. 21st April, Charlotte Brontë's 208th birthday. The weekend will open on Fri. at 7 p.m. with a very special musical event called "An Evening with Charlotte Brontë" devised by Michael and Christine O'Dowd. This presentation draws much from the works of Charlotte's favourite writers, the composer Tom Moore and the poet Bobby Burns. The venue is in the Back Lounge in Corrigan's Corner Pub so come early to secure a good seat. Registration for the weekend is €10 which covers all events. Saturday's events will be held in Crank House with talks by Brontë experts Joanne Wilcock, Pauline Clooney and Maebh O'Regan. Maebh will also show a film about the Banagher Brontë Group's recent formation and participation in the Banagher Patrick's Day Parade. Saturday will close with a gentle amble to view Brontë related works of art and displays in local shop windows and finish with a saunter to the River Shannon's banks.
