Divine Mercy Sunday celebrated on Sun. 11th April. The devotion to Divine Mercy was actively promoted by Pope John Paul II now Saint John Paul. On the 30th April 2000, the canonization of St. Faustina took place on the second Sunday of Easter, which was officially designated as Divine Mercy Sunday. Pope John Paul II died in April 2005 and was beatified on Divine Mercy Sunday 1st May 2011 and canonized with Pope John XXIII on Divine Mercy Sunday 27th April 2014 by Pope Francis.
