Webcam and Live streaming of Mass in the Parish: It is almost a year now since the Parish installed the webcams in St. Rynagh's and St. Mary's for the live-streaming of the celebration of Mass. The cost of the installation was €7,000. and there is also a maintenance fee of €240 per month incl. broadband. We are delighted to have this valuable service in these pandemic times which enables us to be united in prayer. The numbers that tune in from the Parish, from around Ireland and indeed from many other countries is most welcomed and encouraging. As you know the Masses are recorded for 30 days and families can request a Funeral Mass to be broadcast and recorded. This has proved to be a very useful service in the last 12 months especially as people cannot attend or travel a distance. I would like to express my sincere thanks to all who join in and pray on the live-stream and to all who have made generous contributions towards the installation and the monthly maintenance of the webcams.

We were delighted to receive a grant for £2,000 sterling from Allchurches Trust.
