Feast of Our Lady of Knock is celebrated on Tuesday 17th August. The story of Knock began on the 21st August 1879 when Our Lady, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist appeared on the south gable of Knock Parish Church. The miraculous apparition was witnessed by 15 people young and old. Knock is an internationally recognised Marian Shrine. St. John Paul II visited Knock as part of his 1979 visit to Ireland. Pope Francis went to Knock and prayed there in 2018.
