The Healthy Age Friendly Homes Programme aims to support older people to live in their own home with dignity and independence, for as long as possible. This is a free service to people aged 65 years or older. The programmes ambition is to enable everyone to live longer healthier lives by keeping care close to home and expanding the range of health and social care services in the community. It is about providing a range of alternatives for older people who may otherwise transition into long term residential care prematurely. To do this we have appointed a Healthy Age Friendly Homes Coordinator in each Local Authority. Each coordinator will case manage a support package for each person referred, linking the supports from the variety of public, voluntary, private and community agencies in the area. The coordinator will carry out a home-based assessment and, in partnership with the older person, will identify and design a range of supports to enable the older person to continue living independently.
