The Christmas Shoebox Appeal is an annual campaign that delivers gifts straight into the hands of children affected by poverty. Often these shoebox gifts are the only gift that a child will receive at Christmas. What to put in or donate, Pens or pencils, crayons, paper or copy books, colouring books, markers, sharpeners and erasers. Soap (wrapped), hairbrush, comb, toothbrush, toothpaste and facecloths. Socks, underwear, flip flops, hat, scarf and gloves.
