fruits of their mature human and spiritual

but always encounter respect and love.
Help them to live serenely and to feel welcomed
in all the years of life which you give them.
Mary, Mother of all the living,
keep grandparents constantly in your care,

may one day be reunited in our heavenly
homeland,
